© By early 2012, U.S. drug manufacturers will phase out completely the “more concentrated” form of acetaminophen **160 mg/ 1.6 ml** in preference to **160 mg/ 5.0 ml** as a standard in order to help prevent fatal overdoses/ liver damage in infants.
